Welcome to Silverline Montessori Cypress Towne Lake

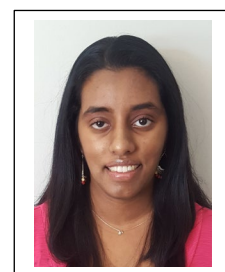
